Which program is right for my child?

ALL PROGRAMS are play-based and provide age appropriate activities focused on child development milestones and kindergarten readiness.

Head Start / Early Head Start

Center (classroom) based programs for children from 6 weeks to 5 years serving low income families. Options include half day or full day including a nutritious meal and snacks. Home visiting programs serve pregnant women and children birth to age 3, with weekly visits and monthly group events focused on the parent & child relationship and child development milestones. Free to qualifying families — Must meet income guidelines.

Preschool for All

IL State Board of Education funded Preschool for 3-5 years including a nutritious meal and snacks. Extended day, Half day, or Full day (in combination with qualifying I.D.H.S. child care) options.

Prenatal to 3 Home Based Programs

Prevention Initiative (PI) and Maternal Infant Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV), Home visiting programs that serve qualifying pregnant women and families birth to age 3. Includes 2 home visits and one group activity per month. Programs provide age appropriate activities focused on the parent & child relationship and child development milestones. Includes opportunities for group socialization and parent workshops. Parent & Child Together (PACT) at St. Pius offers weekly parent and child classes.

Young Parents Program

A full day program for infants and toddlers, ages 6 weeks through 2 years of age that serves pregnant and parenting teens *who attend Morton High School District 201*. Includes Prevention Initiative home visiting program for pregnant women and children birth to age 3 for qualifying families *with parents under age 24*.

Child Care and After School Programs (K - 5th grade)

Full day, developmentally appropriate, play-based, childcare for children age 15 months—5 years for working parents including a U.S.D.A. food program. *School Age Care* Provides a variety of educational and recreational activities after school and during the summer. I.D.H.S. eligibility with sliding co-payment *for qualifying families* based on income and family size.
